Eligibility

Transfer to the Family Retreat at the Park Hyatt Melbourne can only occur if:

- You have had an uncomplicated pregnancy and delivery; and
- Your obstetrician and paediatrician are satisfied that both you and your baby are safe to transfer and have your care continued at the Park Hyatt Melbourne under the supervision of a hospital midwife.

Often there are very sound clinical reasons why your maternity care is best provided in the hospital rather than a hotel. Also, there are times when the Park Hyatt is not available such as when the hotel needs all available rooms for visitors attending major sporting events in Melbourne or St Vincents & Mercy Private decides, at its absolute discretion, that all maternity care should be provided from within the hospital.

The Family Retreat is an option for eligible families to complete their post natal care. In consultation with your obstetrician and maternity liaison midwives, you and your family may be transferred the short distance to the Hotel in a chauffeured vehicle fitted with an Australian Standards approved baby capsule.

Upon arrival at the Hotel, you will be escorted directly to your private hotel room where you and your new family can relax and enjoy all the comforts that Park Hyatt Melbourne has to offer.

What should I bring?

You will need to pack day clothes for the journey to the Hotel and to wear throughout your stay. St. Vincents & Mercy Private recommends you consider comfortable night attire and loose fitting clothes, such as pants with elastic waistbands and tops which allow easy access for breastfeeding. Also remember to include clothes suitable for dinner wear, should you choose to indulge in a celebratory meal in the award-winning radii restaurant.

Luxuriate and relax

Park Hyatt Melbourne is home to large and luxurious guest rooms. All feature indulgent king beds and are styled with sumptuous fabrics, leather, wood and original artworks. Light-filled Italian marble bathrooms feature double glass hand basins and oversized glass showers, and you can bask in relaxing ambience with in-bathroom television and music.

24-hour maternity support

Who covers the cost?
